GARY ALFANO GAVE THE FOLLOWING REPORT ON THE RESULTS OF THE RECENT BABY BOTTLE CAMPAIGN:

So far, we've raised about \$17,500 thanks to the generosity of our parishioners from the six parishes our council supports. (This total will rise since there are bottles still coming in from donors who missed the collection dates). \$8,200 was raised for Bright Hope from the contributions coming from Queenship of Mary, The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary and St. John the Baptist Stiles parishes. \$9,300 was raised for Cay Galgon from the contributions coming from Holy Trinity, St Peter's and St John Fisher.

Note that these totals include our council's \$500 donation to each organization, as well as the \$400 grants each expects to receive from Supreme's ASAP Program (Aid and Support After Pregnancy). These results are wonderful! And the money will be put to good use by Bright Hope and Cay Galgon, in support of life.
